





Netflix's ZERO DAY has Nikita playing the rogue GRU officer Alexi Lebedev who is suspected to have a hand in the major attack.



























Vladimir (KONSTANTIN LAVYSH) has just begun a long sentence for smuggling electronics into the Soviet Union. Vladimir's only friend is Aleksei (NIKI-TA BOGOLYUBOV), a political prisoner, and together they work cutting down trees and constructing new buildings for the camp. Aside from having to deal with impossible quotas, an inadequate diet, and a general feeling of hopelessness, Vladimir is relentlessly beaten by fellow inmates who hate him for being Jewish. Both Vladimir and Aleksei are lucky to be friends, however, as they both end up saving each others' lives. To compound an already horrific situation, Vladimir cannot hope to escape, the one belief that gives gulag inmates any hope for the future: his wife, Elena (VERA CHERNY), is also behind bars in the female part of the gulag. With everything stacked against him, Vladimir is reduced to the single option of transforming himself into something he never thought possible, a change that will heighten the chances of survival for him and his wife. He must find a way to join the Vory v Zakonye, or Thieves-in-Law, an elite Russian criminal organization going back to the time of the czars.



Nikita Bogolyubov was born in Leningrad, USSR (now St. Petersburg, Russia). He had his first taste of being an entertainer from ice skating when he was four years old. His family immigrated to the US when Nikita was only eight years old which allowed him to stay fluent in both English and Russian.

Nikita's television debut came from NBC's Prime Suspect where he had a scene opposite of Maria Bello. Wanting to showcase more of his versatility, he also worked in various projects at the American Film Institute (AFI).

For his feature film The Saratov Approach, Larry King exclaimed at the premiere that Nikita "stole the movie" with his performance.

He has since been cast on ABC's Castle, CBS' Scorpion, FX's Legion, HBO's Barry, and NETFLIX's Iron Fist.
